

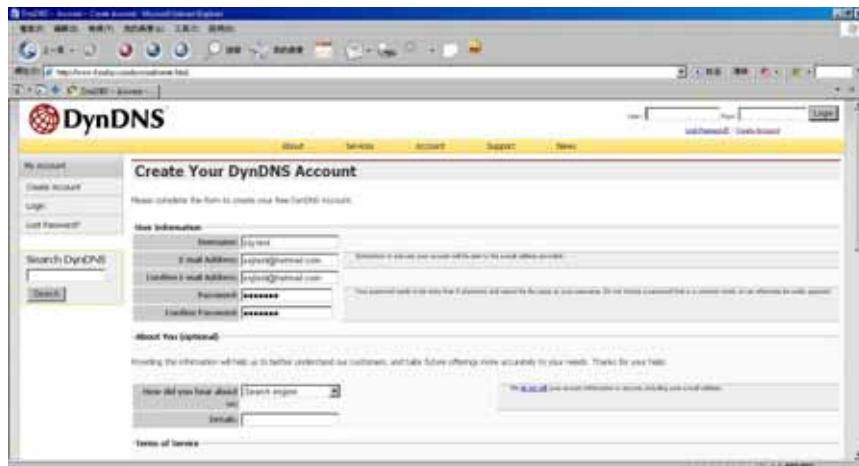
DynDNS Service Setup Procedure

1. Create New Account

- I. Using the IE Browser and link in to DynDNS web site at the following address:
<http://www.dyndns.com>

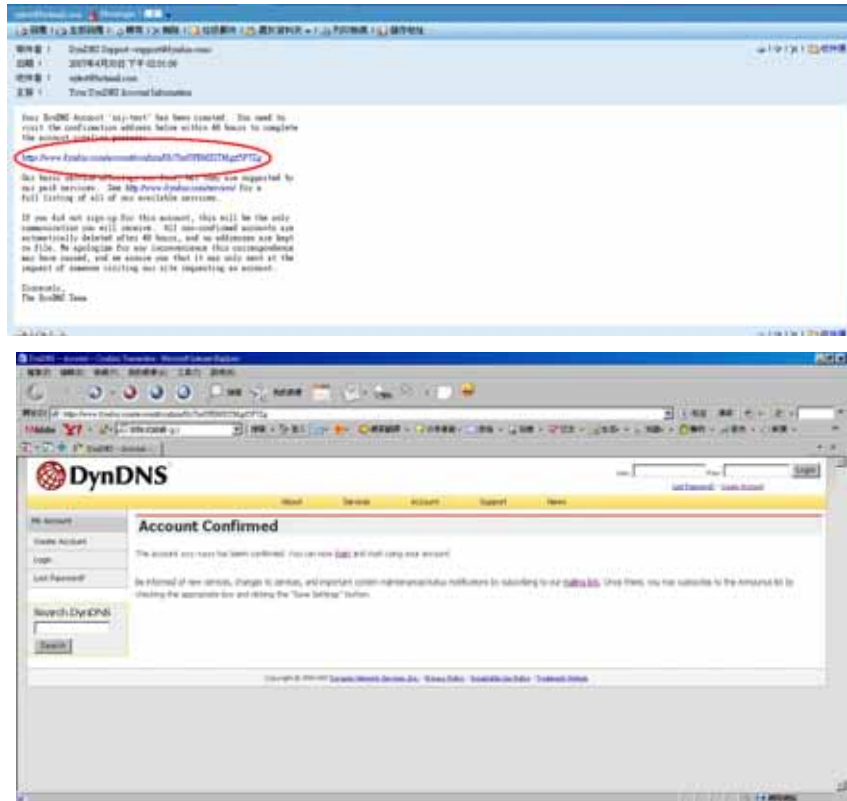


- II. On the main page, press on the [Create Account](#) link, and you will see the following page for creating a new account.



- III. In this page, enter the required information as instructed, and then press the “Create Account” button.

- IV. If all information is entered correctly. An “Account Created” page will be displayed, and a confirmation email will be send to the email account entered.
- V. Retrieve the confirmation email, and press the confirmation link in the email. An “Account Confirmed” Page, and this account is ready for usage now.



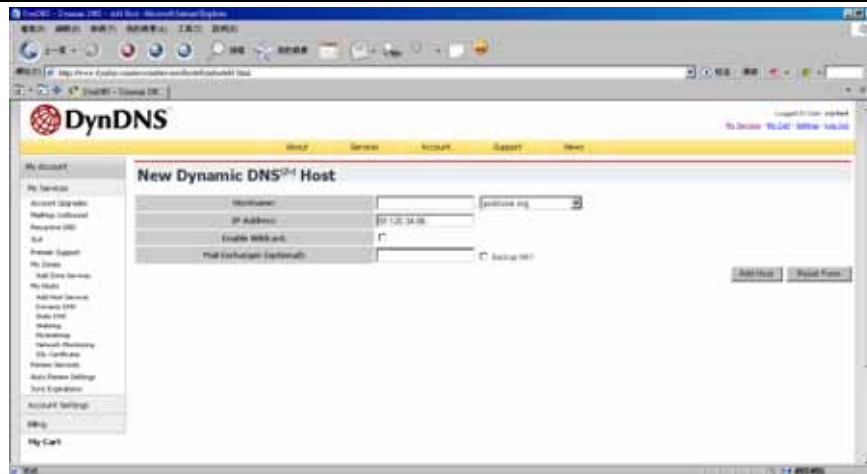
2. Login to DynDNS service

- I. Using the IE Browser and link in to DynDNS web site at the following address: <http://www.dyndns.com>
- II. Enter the user name and password and press “Login”.

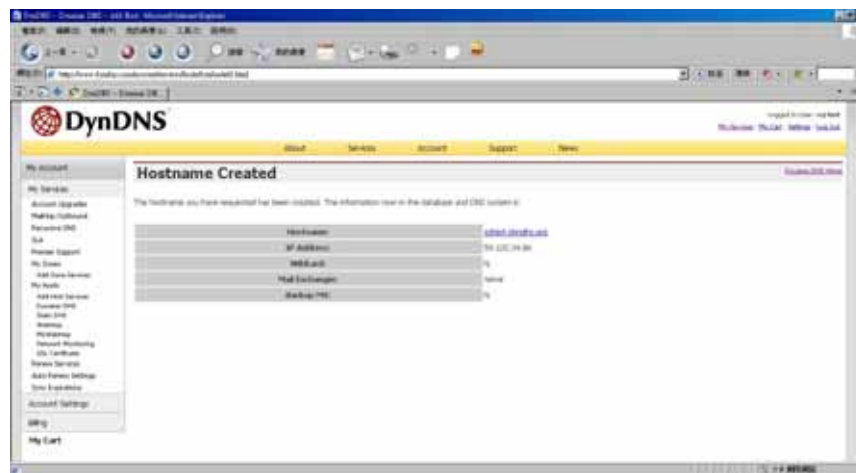


3. Create dynamic DNS Host

- I. Click on the “My Services” link. Since this is the first time you login to the



- V. Click on the Add Host button. If there is no duplicate in the hostname selected, then the “Hostname Created” page will come up. Now this hostname is ready for usage then.



4. Setting up the DDNS Setup page

The Hostname created here is the Domain name that you used to enter into the DDNS setup page. The user name and the password created here should also be entered in respectively. You can check the DDNS setup by click on the “Manual” button. This will force an update to the DynDNS server.

Then you can check the “Last Updated” information in the DynDNS Hosts page. It should display the last successful update time in there. Then your DDNS update is ready for use then.
